Dennis Sundby of Underwood, ND obtained his 1943 White Autocar M3A1 Half-track from Grand Forks, ND. Don Purper (MVPA# 17969) restored this vehicle. MVPA Member Don had spent over 8 years working on it, getting parts from three different M3A1's. He used it for parades, giving rides to WWII vets.



Dennis trailed it from Grand Forks to Underwood, and has been busy finalizing some of the items. He recently installed the "Pulpit" with a ring mount and skate for

his 50 cal. SMG. the gun ring, and had the drive train worked on by Ray Herr (Mvpa#29071) of Turtle Lake (Ray has a fully equipped machine shop available.). Dennis is using it for small town parades, and reports that the crowds love seeing it come around the corner.

Dennis is going to bring the M3A1 to Bismarck in September for the Street fair, and will then take it over to the Air Museum at Fargo for the September 20-27 WW-II tribute. The Air Museum has offered to display the Half-Track this winter.
