Volkowitsch Golf Open Hole Rules

This tournament is a **SCRAMBLE**, each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The better of the second shots is determined, and then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.

Mulligan's are \$5 per person; only two per person, each team can have a maximum of 8 mulligan's.

All par 4's and 5's will have the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer pink ribbon in the middle of each fairway. If your ball comes to rest on or inside the ribbon, please put your name on the list and you will be entered into a drawing for a prize. The shot does not need to be the tee shot, it can happen on any shot during the hole.

On the par 3's there will be tickets you can purchase to win prizes. If you hit the green with your tee shot, tickets will be doubled with a better chance to win.

Prizes will be awarded during dinner. Prizes Include:

- 1st Through 3rd Low Net Foursome
- 1st For Low Gross Foursome
- Closest To The Pin
- Longest Putt
- Longest Drive
- Farthest Away
- Pink Ribbon Prizes
- Par 3 Ticket Prizes

Hole #1 (Pink Ribbon):

Each player on the team will tee off; the drive that ends up closest to the pink ribbon must be used.

Hole #2 (Tough Guy):

The player who hits it on the green in two and is the closest to the pin gets a prize.

Hole #3 (Little Man's Driver):

Each player tees off with the kid's size driver.

Hole #4 (Farthest Away):

The player who is farthest from the pin and still on the green in one shot wins a prize.

Hole #6 (Big Man's Driver):

Each player must use the OVERSIZED driver off the tee box.

Hole #7 (Pink Mitts):

Each player must wear the pink breast cancer oven mitts while teeing off.

Hole #8 (Tin Cup Hole):

Each player must pick any of the supplied items in the bucket to use as their club to hit a tee shot, please return the item back in the bucket when you are finished.

Hole #9 (Longest Putt):

The player that makes the longest putt on this hole will win a prize.

Hole #11 (Happy Gilmore):

Each player must take a running shot from the tee, they can not be standing still, MUST swing just like HAPPY did in the movie. If you haven't seen the movie, someone in your group can demonstrate for you.

Hole #12 (Big Game):

Players must shoot and putt around the geese, ducks and deer decoys placed on and around the green.

Hole #13 (Lefty's Only):

Each player must putt with the left handed putter only; if you are left handed you must putt with a right handed putter.

Hole #14 (Closest To Pin):

The player who is closest to the pin will win a prize.

Hole #15 (Roll The Pink Dice):

All players tee off, and then the team shakes the dice after everyone has hit and the number it lands on is the player's ball you must use.

Hole #16 (Long Ball):

The player who hits the longest drive while staying in the fairway wins a prize.

Hole #18 (Iron Man):

Each player must use an iron on every shot (no hybrids), until your team reaches the green.
